Dear Parents and Caregivers,

It has been nice to have some reprieve from the extreme weather conditions since the start of the school year. While we are fortunate to have reverse cycle air-conditioning in all classrooms across our school, it has still been oppressive outside and going to and from the swimming pool for the past fortnight. It has also impacted on the amount of time the children have spent outside in the first 5 weeks of the school year.

Swimming Lessons Wrap

It is with a sigh of relief that we celebrate the end of the fortnight of swimming lessons. We do acknowledge the importance of them and the need for the children to develop their swimming skills, but it does certainly impact on the routines here at school. Congratulations to all the children for their efforts in developing their skills and I hope that was reflected in the certificates that were distributed yesterday. Thanks also to the staff and parents who supported the children throughout the fortnight as well.

Swimming Carnival Preparation

As we prepare for the upcoming carnivals on Friday, a reminder to all families to ensure the permission note, handed out yesterday to travel to the venue on the bus is returned. The carnivals will again take place at St Brigid's College, Lesmurdie on the Boarder's Long Weekend, meaning there will not be any students at the school. The plan for the day includes:

Year 1's and 2's – leaving school on the bus at 8:45am with their carnival due to start at 9:30am and conclude at approximately 10:45am. The children will be swimming in 5 novelty events in the shallow pool before returning to school on the bus at 11am. The children will be asked to bring their morning tea with them, to eat at the conclusion of the carnival.

Year 3's to 6's - will be split into 2 groups. Those children who have completed stage 4 and feel confident to swim 25M in the big pool will participate in the main carnival in the 25M pool. The children who have not reached stage 4 yet or do not feel as confident will participate in the novelty carnival in the shallow pool at the same time. We are aiming to start these 2 carnivals at 11am and conclude by approximately 2pm, before getting on the buses at 2:15pm and returning to school. The children will

need to bring their own food for the day and snack between events. Parents are encouraged to join us at St Brigid's to watch the carnivals.

An important message to all families is that the canteen will be closed for the day!

Commissioning/Commitment Mass

All families in our community are invited to our Commissioning Mass on Sunday, 10 March at 10am at Good Shepherd Church. The Mass is an opportunity for us to gather as a community and for some keys groups within our community to pledge their commitment to the Good Shepherd community including – Staff, Parish catechists, School Advisory Council members, P&F Executive members and the Parish Council members.

The children receiving the sacraments of: Reconciliation, Holy Communion and Confirmation this year are also asked to pledge their commitment to the programs in front of the community. If these families cannot attend the Sunday morning Mass, they are encouraged to attend on Saturday night, with the Mass starting at 6pm or Sunday night at 6pm. The children are asked to bring their commitment forms to the Mass and will be asked to pledge their commitment in front of the community.

Sacramental Parent Information Evening - Years 3, 4 and 6

The parents of the children receiving the sacraments of Reconciliation in Year 3, Holy Communion in Year 4 and Confirmation in Year 6 are asked to attend the Sacramental Parent Information Night in Ward House on Wednesday 6th March, starting at 6pm. Father Pavol will present some information regarding sacraments in general before the classroom teachers share information pertinent to the respective sacraments. Attendance on the night is an important part of the process of the children receiving the sacrament.

Carpark Etiquette

I feel like I need to remind all parents of some important carpark etiquette, with my motivation being to increase the chances of this busy part of our school being as safe as possible for the children and their families. Some important reminders include:

- · Please drive your car no faster than 8kmph
- \cdot $\;\;$ Please use the crosswalks and concrete paths when moving across the carpark
- \cdot $\,$ Please follow the arrows to ensure the traffic moves in the same direction
- · Please refrain from using the overflow carpark beyond the gardener's shed unless the main carpark is full. This reduces the traffic going across the main crosswalk and ensures a safer environment for the children

Throughout these assessments, we ask the children to do their very best to ensure the results reflect their skills and knowledge and parents refrain from organising appointments during this time if possible to reduce the potential for the children to be away from school.

On-Line Safety Presentation

One of our parents, Larissa Simpson has extended an invitation to all parents in our community to attend an "On-Line Safety Presentation" designed for parents of 3-12 year old children. 
