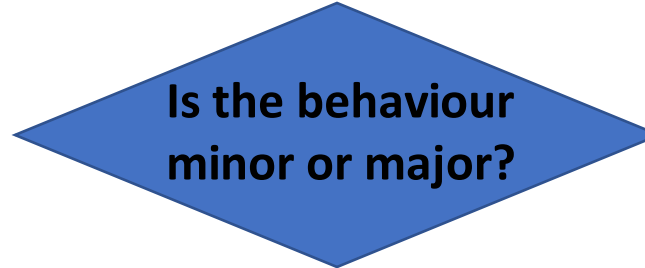




# Good Shepherd Behaviour Flow Chart

**Playground:**  
Sit out of play for a number of minutes

**Classroom:**  
Separate student from distraction



Walk with the duty teacher or community service

Withdraw from class and complete behavior think sheet



If required inform classroom teacher

Parent contacted



If behaviour continues, refer to major offense

Examples of Minor behaviours Playground	Examples of Major behaviours Playground
No hat	Rough play
Running on the red bricks	Swearing
Not playing safe	Bullying and intimidation
Not keeping hands and feet to yourself	Vandalising or damaging property
Going out of bounds	Deliberate physical harm
Not sharing equipment and games	Deliberately disobeying a teacher's instructions
Leaving a mess after eating	
Speaking unkindly	stealing
Sharing food	
Not including others in games or play	
Examples of Minor behaviours in the class	Examples of Major behaviours in the class
Not following class rules	Speaking disrespectfully
Late to class after recess or lunch	Stealing
Not completing classwork	Damaging property
No copying others work	Disobeying teacher
Incomplete homework	Inappropriate use of technology
Not keeping hands and feet to yourself	Inappropriately touching another person
Not following teacher instructions	
Disturbing other
