In order to thrive, and show up for our kids, we need to ensure we have our mental health in check. Just like we look after our physical health, mental health is just as important!

It's normal to have 'off' days and experience feelings of sadness, anger, stress or even anxiety. However if you find this persists on an ongoing basis, it's important to seek support.

Modelling this to your kids and teaching them to prioritise mental health will also allow them to understand and express their emotions too!

Top Tips

- **1. Have a broad range of interests** including (work, family, sport, hobbies) and spend time on the things you enjoy.
- **2. Develop skills to help you cope** in stressful situations e.g. relaxation techniques or anger management.
- **3. Develop a support group** of people you feel comfortable to talk to and can trust, and nurture these relationships.


Tournament Group Registration form by 12 October
