



Application Process for Enrolment at Good Shepherd Catholic Primary School

Thank you for your interest in Good Shepherd Catholic Primary School. The following information will guide you through the application process for students wishing to attend Good Shepherd Catholic Primary School.

Complete **all** sections in the Application for Enrolment Form and arrange for your Parish Priest to complete the Parish Priest Reference Form. Please return the application to the Enrolments Officer in the School Office together with the following documentation.

- Birth Certificate
- Immunisation Record – Medicare/MyGov record only
- Baptism Certificate
- If born outside of Australia - Visa/Passport documentation or Australian Citizenship Certificate for both the child and parents
- Parish Priest Reference
- Current School report, NAPLAN (Yr 3 & 5), Bishop's Literacy Assessment (Yr 3 & 5) - *if applicable*

If your application is successful, you will be contacted and invited to attend an interview with the School Principal before a place at Good Shepherd is offered.

Criteria for Enrolment

Primary

- Catholic students from the parish with a Parish Priest reference
- Siblings of Catholic / non-Catholic students
- Catholic students from outside the Parish with a Parish Priest reference
- Other Catholic students
- Non-Catholic students from other Christian denominations
- Other non-Catholic students.

Starting Age

Students who are enrolling in Kindergarten must turn 4 before the 30 June of the enrolling year. School is compulsory from Pre-Primary.

Students enrolling in the 3 Year Old Pre-Kindergarten Program must turn 3 before they can start.
