**Dear Parents and Caregivers,**

Welcome back to school for the new school term, an 11 week term which will include 6 fortnightly newsletters on the fortnight, every second Wednesday on the "odd" weeks, weeks 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11. We will continue to celebrate the events happening at school and pre-empt upcoming events to ensure our community is prepared for the variety of events that will take place throughout the term.

### **Uniform Change**

As we move into Term 2, a reminder to all parents that we have a 2-week transition into the Winter uniform. The uniform shop continues to be open on Monday afternoons to assist parents to ensure their children have been able to make the transition. Help your child build gratitude by making it apart of every day life

It doesn't need to be big or complicated. In fact, it works best when it's simple, consistent, and real. When kids see you noticing the good - especially on ordinary days - they start to understand what gratitude looks and feels like.

**Try this:**

Pick one of these to start this week:

- **Daily check-in:** At dinner or bedtime, share one or two things you're grateful for, and ask your child the same.
- **Say it out loud:** Model it in the moment. "I'm really grateful for this sunshine today," or "I loved spending time with you this afternoon."
- **Start a gratitude jar:** Add notes throughout the year and read them together later.

Even on days that aren't all that crash hot, this helps kids see that there's always something worth noticing.
